Recently I had the privilege of presenting to a farm discussion group in Alfredton. We had a great whiteboard session. The farmers, mainly ladies, provided production and cost figures on a per thousand ewe basis. We compared those figures with the numbers being achieved by Qlabs clients. With full agreement, from the group, a 50 000 dollar increase in income per thousand ewes was identified when comparing the Qlabs client figures to the figures supplied by the group. That is not a typo - it was \$50 000 per 1000 ewes.
